### LOWESTOFT HELP FOR STARVING HUNGARIAN FAMILIES

Ildiko would like to try and organize regular donations to the group Parcel Aid which helps Hungarian families. She says, "When last time I was in Hungary I visited this charity. We prepared bags of food for 3 families. What they put in a bag is enough to survive but quiet poor. Look:

What is in the bag? 2 kg flour, 1 kg semolina, 1 kg sugar, 500 g margarine, 500 g bean, 500 g yellow peas, little sachet of seasoning, and 2 boxes of baby food, some toiletries.

There is no proper protein.

There are different ways to help them: one is we could send milk powder and they will share it. Or other source of protein.

Cheese, canned meat. Or any idea accepted.

This charity name in English is Parcel Aid, on the FB it is exactly ParcelAid-SZOCSONA."
