## BANNS OF MARRIAGE APPLICATION—NOTES

One person may complete this form on behalf of both.

At least two weeks' notice is required before the first reading of the Banns. Banns must be read on three successive Sundays within three months of the marriage.

(Section 3) If either of you will not be 18 years old by the proposed date of your marriage the consent of your parents or guardians will need to be obtained.

(Sections 4, 11, 12) Although the decision to permit the marriage in church of anyone who has been divorced from a husband or wife who is still living is left to the incumbent, the consent of the Diocesan Bishop may be sought in extraordinary circumstances.

***(Section 15) This means the Church of England ecclesiastical parish in which you live. If you are unsure which parish you live in you can use the website [achurchnearyou.com](http://achurchnearyou.com) to check.***

If either or both of you lives in a different parish from that in which the marriage is to take place you must also arrange for the Banns to be read and obtain a Banns certificate from that parish as well.
