THE CHURCH OF ENGLAND SUFFOLK

New Lead Chaplain appointed at Sizewell C



The Revd Clive Mobbs, who grew up in East Suffolk, started the role of the new Chaplain at Sizewell C on Monday 28 October thanks to a partnership between Sizewell C and the Church of England in Suffolk. Clive is just the third Chaplain to ever be employed at a UK power station. "I think it's a bit like a Venn diagram - physical health, mental health and spiritual health - and they all overlap," Clive said. "Somewhere in the middle is the whole person. I'm there for everybody - I am the Chaplain for all the faiths and none. It will also be important to work alongside the various parishes in the area, to work closely with them so we are welcoming hosts in Suffolk and our communities." Clive said he had been supported by the Revd Ewen Huffman, Chaplain at Hinkley Point power station, who was the first to take up a chaplaincy role at a UK power station.
